

## Check Out the Average Day for a Senior High camper at Mingus Mountain!

Note that the Senior High campers have a later start to the day and a later bedtime. They also get to work with their small group to determine what activities they'd like to do.

\*For activity choices, the small groups will receive a schedule with Bible Study and Camp Store filled in already and then they will choose how they want to fill in the rest of their schedule based on what their group would like to do. A sample schedule might look like the following with the items in **green** being the items the group would choose, as lead by their counselors.

Note: High Ropes is in two back-to-back slots because it will take about 2 hours for the group to have the best experience.

\*Activity Rotations include the following:

- Bible Study: campers will have a Bible Study activity each day
- Archery: campers will get to shoot archery three times during the week
- Crafts: campers will get to make crafts at least twice during the week
- Sports & Games: at least 2 times per week
- Low Ropes/Team-Building: 2 times per week

- Hiking: 2 times per week
- Nature: 2 times per week
- Music & Drama: 1-2 times per week
- Fishing: at least 1 time per week
- Camp Store: 2 visits per week (items from the Camp Store will also be available upon drop off and pick up)
- Camper Choice: Campers will choose, within their small groups, what activity they want to do during this time.

Night-Time Activities will be theme-based and could include a variety of activities such as:

Junior/Senior High Nature Camp – in addition to enjoying camp favorites including archery, campfires, and high ropes, Nature Camp participants will explore the flora and fauna of Mingus Mountain, learn about the human impact on the earth, and take field trips to encounter creation work in a different way.

Due to the nature of Senior High Adventure Camp and Senior High Adventures in Mission Camp, we're not ready to publish a schedule but a full schedule will be made available to parents and campers by early May!

We can share that Senior High Adventure campers will hike in the Prescott Dells, canoe/kayak in Watson Lake, camp and hike in Sedona, hang out in Oak Creek, tube the Verde River, as well as spend time at camp doing all the traditional camp activities.

Senior High Adventures in Mission Camp will combine missions work such as working at local food banks, doing home improvement work, and providing leadership at local churches, with hiking Thumb Butte, canoe/kayak in Prescott, and experiencing the Adventure Course in Flagstaff.
